## COVIDSafe Plan

### Important Points

You should read through this entire plan. However, the core points to note are:

- Bring a face mask.
- If you need to take your mask off, do not be in a large group of players.
- Personal food or drinks are permitted; sharing them is not.
- You must arrive by 3:30pm, in order to be present for the COVIDSafe briefing. If you are not, you will have to wait outside until you can be briefed.
- After the game ends, please remain to assist in cleaning the venue. Players who leave early will not be asked to return.

### Physical Distancing

- In order to comply with physical distancing requirements, we've used a large hall with a huge amount of space, allowing for much more than 4 square meters per person.
- We have ensured no more than 50 people will be in attendance, the maximum amount for either room or for an event of this type.
- A small sign will be added for the small side rooms and bathrooms indicating the limit on number of people that can enter.
- Players are encouraged to maintain a 1.5m distance from groups when not wearing masks, such as while eating or drinking.
- Sharing food is not allowed, though you're welcome to bring personal snacks and drinks.

### Face Coverings

- You must have a fitted facemask, in accordance with Victorian Government guidelines.
- You may take off your facemask when outdoors or to eat/drink.

### Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer will be provided at the entrance to the rooms and outside the bathroom and kitchen; you're encouraged to sanitize your hands often, and especially after eating or using the bathroom.
- Please remain after the game to assist in sanitizing the venue (mopping and wiping down all surfaces).
- All surfaces will be cleaned with a 1:1 000 PPM sodium hypochlorite solution.

### Record-Keeping and Acting Quickly

- All players are required to submit their name and email address before signing up, for potential contact tracing.
- You should not attend if you are feeling unwell.
- You must verbally confirm before entry that you are free of symptoms, have not been in contact with a confirmed case and have not been directed to isolate.
- You must attend the COVIDSafe briefing, starting at 3:30pm. If you are late, you will be asked to wait outside until you can be briefed personally.

### Avoiding Enclosed Spaces

- All windows and doors in the venue will be kept open to maximize ventilation.
